

## ARCHDIOCESAN GUIDELINES FOR CREMATION

- Remains of cremated bodies should be treated with the same respect given to the corporal remains of a human body.
- The cremated remains of a body should be entombed in a mausoleum or columbarium; they may also be buried in a grave in a cemetery.
- The practice of scattering cremated remains in the sea, from the air, or on the ground or keeping cremated remains in the home of a relative or friend of the deceased is not the reverent disposition that the church requires.
- Whenever possible, appropriate means of memorialization should be utilized.

## Rules

- Headstone or marker must be installed within 1 year of burial for cemetery plot.
- No one may plant permanent flowers, trees, or plants on cemetery plots. Nor do we allow any type of permanent fencing, hedging, or borders.
- The placement of a permanent posted planter on the south side of the marker is permitted. The planter is to be placed two feet above the ground and only one planter is allowed per marker.
- Artificial flowers and other grave decorations may be removed at the discretion of the Cemetery Director according to appearance due to wear. This includes items left after a funeral.
- One wreath may be placed on the grave three weeks before Christmas and will be removed two weeks after Christmas.
- Loose flowers, potted plants, vases, and other decorative items are allowed only two weeks before Memorial Day and must be removed no later than one week after Memorial Day.
