Liturgical Principles & Policies

Flowers are expected and welcome at the funeral celebration as a natural expression of condolence. All flowers and plants brought to the church may be displayed in the area around the baptismal font during the visitation. Prior to the beginning of the service, one or two family arrangements may be placed in the area of the altar platform. The placement of flowers and plants may at no time cause the altar, ambo or presider’s chair to be obstructed from view. (Except during Advent/Christmas/Lent/Easter seasons.)
