Updates from Father T	- Music director: Looking for a music director, one applicant currently, interview process starting next week. - Faith Formation: Working on a job description for a faith formation person – may be distribution of duties, really adjusting to just look for an Administrator. Position doesn't need to be both a theologian and administrator, just need an administrator. - Christmas giving: Christmas giving numbers were up even with smaller attendance at Christmas masses. - Men's Retreat \ Women's Retreat: Women's retreat – March 10 th -12 th , Men's Retreat – April – all are invited. - Synod: 14 instead of 12 – added one person because it is the Eucharist Revival Year (Andrea Krautkramer, Tom and Michelle Mills, Dr. Sorokin, Father Aric, Deacon Pat, Karen, Brady Tynen, Anne Carraux, Jackie Craigmile, Kathleen Schultz, Bill and Justine Bojan, Holly Gherkin.) Kickoff event coming up in Lakeville. The 14 will attend 7 week training at St. Therese in Deephaven, trained first, and then focus on small group initiative.

Discussion of Synod Letter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Father T. did a walkthrough of the Introduction – - Key point: Importance of encounter – listen carefully and not be automatically dismissive of viewpoints. - 3 priorities: 1st priority – focused on the institution of the parish, forming parishes and 2nd priority – focused on the formation of the people, forming missionary disciples. - Formation (training) will happen of the 14 and the small group leaders. - Synods – (Walk together) – Father T mentioned that there was a lot of language about the priests. Vatican II – communion of the family, communion of the parish, archdiocese in communion with the pope - Apostle is someone who is sent - Disciple someone who is learning - Synodality – thinking together as a team, or a communion of churches - Evangelization Vicar – Father Lenny Andrie - Finding Clarity in the Upper Room – gives us an image to focus on. 3 mysteries – washing of the feet, breaking of the bread, and the coming of the holy spirit - Reactions to meditations on the image of the upper room – intimacy of the setting, gathering them in, preparing, loving and nurturing them. Humility, selfless leadership, compassion, safe place when they may have feared for their life. Jesus will provide for their (our) safety. Toxic culture outside, upper room is a safe place. We don't have cause for fear because our lives are in His hands. Not fear but prudence. Resistance to the Pentecost step because they don't know how to do that, overwhelming to parish priests to think about how far they need to reach to evangelize. Upper room is a place of formation and then at Pentecost, it is instant and that same Holy Spirit is with us today. Holy Spirit is a spark plug. - Something to think about – think about pastoral care, charity and justice, hospitality are related to the first pillar of washing the feet. How are we taking care of these within St. Hubert? – mental illness, older people, funerals, poor, could be also a great disparity between the wealthy and poor. 	<p>For next meeting:</p> <p>Paragraphs 18-27, through the washing of the feet.
